

The club has been permitted to add a retractable fuel line on the dock to improve fuel efficiency and limit risk. There will still be efforts to raise capital to complete the project and sponsors/donors are welcomed.

Additionally, slip agreements and assignments are being renewed. Members have volunteered to donate trenching/connection work for the fueling job and have been put in charge of that connection withPeter and Chris. Suggestions from a previous dock walk and made a to-do list, which included removingan old flagpole, hanging bird flags, and replacing some plank boards. The Committee discussed plansfor marina events, including a Memorial Day Friday dock event, a charity Bayside Poker Run on July 29,a fall event, and the Rockfish tournament on December 8-10. Finally, they decided to move their advisory meetings to

the second Thursday of each month to avoid conflicts with other Wednesday club events, with the next meeting scheduled for Thursday, May 11, 2023 at 5:30 pm.
