

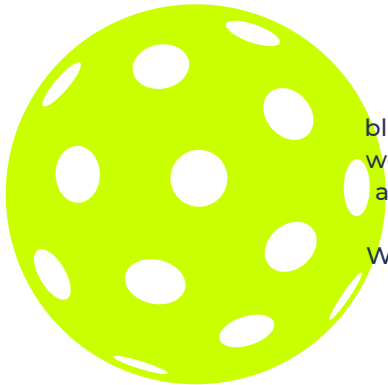

Racket Sports News

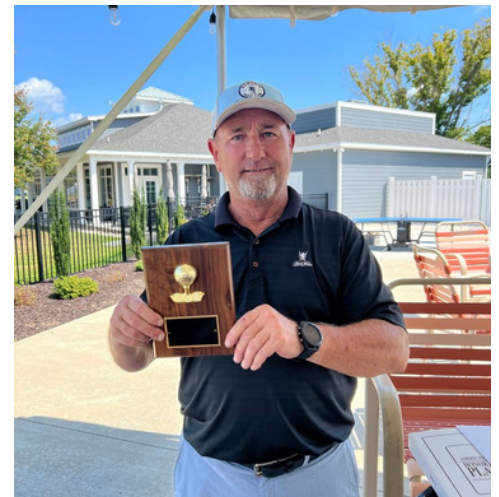

Ladies Club Championship

And 9-Hole Championship

September 13 and 15

Sponsored by the Ladies Golf Association

Open to all female full golf members at ESYCC

Non-LGA members will be charged a \$25.00 entry fee. There is no charge for LGA members (This is included in the dues paid by LGA members.). This will be 2 days of stroke play with handicaps. 80% of the players handicap will be used. The entrants will be flighted if enough ladies sign up. Tee times will be assigned with all players starting on the first hole beginning at 9:00 a.m. both days. Players in the 9-Hole Championship will tee off after the last group of 18-hole players, and play only the front 9 holes.

On the first day, players with the 4 lowest handicaps will be in the first group, etc. On the second day, players will be regrouped by scores from the first day (the lowest 4 scores go off first, etc.). In the event of a tie there will be a playoff at the end of the second round; sudden death beginning on the first hole.

Everyone will be flighted once the sign-up sheet is completed.

There is no limit as to how many players can sign up--- the more the better.

GOLF --We plan to have 4 flights with 6 two-man teams in each flight. We will play one 9-hole match on Thursday at 1p.m. We will play two 9-hole matches on Friday starting at 9:30 a.m. with lunch served in between. Saturday, we will play two 9-hole matches starting at 9:30 a.m. with lunch served in between. A sudden-death playoff will follow at 2:30, with an awards ceremony at 4:00. Every player MUST have an established GHIN handicap number. Absent of that, you must produce at least 5 18-hole scores for the COMMITTEE to use to establish one for you. NO EXCEPTIONS!

SOCIAL ACTIVITIES--- Thursday the 22nd will feature a BBQ Dinner and a CALCUTTA to auction off the teams.

Friday night the 23rd we'll have Cocktails and a Dinner/Dance with a DJ.

Saturday the 24th, there will be an Awards Ceremony immediately following the sudden-death playoff, with appetizers and a cash bar.
